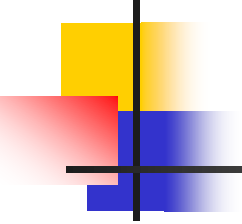

- Making Friends

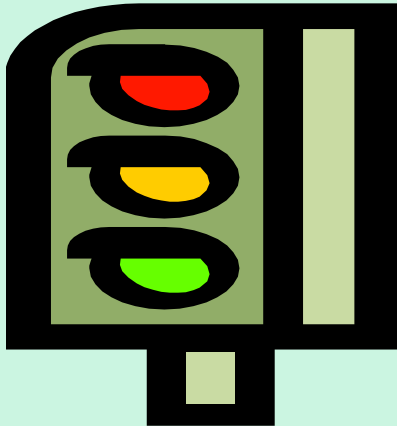
